INSTRUCTIONS TO ASSESSORS AND COLLECTORS.

EXEMPT FROM TAXATION.

The following persons are exempt from all internal taxes: His Majesty the King, the Diplomatic Agents of foreign countries and their attaches duly made known to the Department of Foreign Affairs. The following persons are exempt from personal taxes: All clergymen of any Christian denomination regularly engaged in their vocation, all teachers of youth employed in public or private schools for more than six months of the year, all soldiers in actual service and all volunteer soldiers duly enrolled and actually doing duty, and all active members in good standing of the Fire Department of Honolulu and of other towns where a fire department now exists or may hereafter be organized; provided that the commanding officer of each such corps and the secretary of the fire department, shall deliver under oath to the Assessor of the district a statement showing the name of the members of such corps or department as entitled to exemption on or before the second day of July in each year; and provided, that no exemption shall be allowed from personal taxes unless the parties claiming such exemption shall notify the Assessor of the district during the month of July of such claims, and the grounds thereof.

Real property belonging to the King or Queen, to the Government, to the Board of Education for the use of schools, to incorporated or private schools, to the Queen's Hospital, to religious societies, for church sites, and burying grounds; such church sites and burying grounds not to exceed five acres in extent, are exempt from taxation. Personal property belonging to the King or Queen, or to the Government, to the Board of Education for the use of schools, to incorporated or private schools, and to the Queen's Hospital is also exempt. Provided always, that the tax of one per cent. hereinbefore imposed upon property shall be collected only upon property in excess of the value of three hundred dollars, be the same real or personal; provided, however, that no exemption shall be allowed from the property of corporations, companies, estates of deceased persons or non-residents, and the exemption of three hundred dollars, under the provision of this Act, shall be allowed in but one district of the Kingdom, and that district shall be the one in which the property owner resides.

All property must be assessed in the district in which it is situated for its full cash value, but if such property is subject to any mortgage, the owner shall make a return of the amount of such mortgage and the date thereof, and the name of the mortgagee, but the owner must pay the full amount of tax thereon for which it may be assessed—see Section 24. Every person having the custody or possession of a horse or other animal or other personal property subject to taxation, shall be deemed the owner thereof, and shall be taxed for the same.

TAX ON REAL ESTATE.

Real estate includes all lands and town lots, with the buildings, structures, fences, wharves, improvements and other things erected on or affixed to the same, and is subject to a tax of one dollar upon every one hundred dollars of its assessed value.

TAX ON PERSONAL PROPERTY.

Personal property includes all household furniture and effects, jewelry, watches, goods and chattels not specifically taxed, wares and merchandise, machinery, all ships and vessels—whether at home or abroad, all monies in hand, leasehold and chattle interests in lands and real estate, franchises, patents, contracts, growing crops, public stocks and bonds, and all domesticated birds and animals, and is subject to a tax of one dollar upon every one hundred dollars of its assessed value. Leasehold interests must be assessed as personal property against the owner of the beneficial interests therein, whether such leases are of Government or Crown lands or otherwise.

CARRIAGE TAX.

All carriages and wagons drawn by one or more horses or mules, used for the conveyance of persons, are subject to an annual tax of five dollars each.

POLL TAX.

Every male inhabitant of the Kingdom, between the ages of seventeen and sixty years, whether a subject or an alien, is subject to an annual poll-tax of one dollar.

DOG TAX.

All dogs pay a yearly tax of one dollar, and ten cents for a tag.

SCHOOL TAX.

Every male inhabitant of the Kingdom, between the ages of twenty and sixty years, whether a subject or an alien, is liable to an annual tax of two dollars each.

ROAD TAX.

Every male inhabitant of the Kingdom, between the ages of seventeen and fifty years, whether a subject or an alien, is subject to an annual road tax of two dollars each. All carts and drays shall pay a tax of two dollars, aside from their value as personal property.

NOTE.—Hawaiian sailors in vessels bound on foreign voyages, whether native or naturalized, commute for all their personal taxes at the time of shipment, and consequently are liable only for the tax on their real and personal property, their animals and carriages.

All fire, marine and life insurance companies carrying on business in this Kingdom, shall pay for and in respect of every one hundred dollars received by such companies respectively for premiums on policies issued by such companies during the year preceding the assessment the sum of two dollars, and such company shall not be charged with any other taxes or duties.

Consuls of foreign nations are not exempted from taxation by the laws of this Kingdom, or by the laws of nations.

ASSESSORS.

Assessors should commence their work as soon after July 1st as possible, but should first take the required oath, a copy of which must be sent to the Minister of Finance, as no Assessor can receive pay for his services until this is done, and at the same time Assessors should file the required bond. Forms for assessment lists should be presented to property holders to be filled and sworn to. Assessors should call upon persons to ascertain the amount of taxes each is liable to pay, and must give public notice, by written or printed advertisements, to the inhabitants to meet him at convenient points in the district for that purpose during the month of July. If any person shall fail to give the assessor his sworn list of property liable to taxation, or to give information of the same before the first day of August, the assessor will make the assessment up from the best information he can obtain, and the same shall be binding on all parties, and shall not be subject to appeal. Assessors should, on or before the 1st day of September, give written notices to all owners of real estate in their district, who are non-residents of the district and within this Kingdom, describing the property assessed and the proposed valuation, provided the parties have made their returns and the Assessor has not raised them any.

All returns by tax-payers must be sworn to.

Assessors should fill out all the columns on the left hand pages only, and must foot all the columns except the first and second, and prove the footings, in order to avoid mistakes. When the pages are all footed and proved, they must recapitulate the footings by pages, writing only on the left hand pages. When the books are completed they must, before passing them to the Governor, take and subscribe before a Police or District Justice an oath, to be written on the first page of each book, stating that "This book is the Assessment Book for the District of..... in the Island of..... for the year 188...". Assessors should use every means in their power to ascertain the values of property, noting improvements made since last assessment, and not follow the book of the year before too closely.

Each Assessor must attend on all days except Sunday, between the 20th day of September and the 1st day of October, at some convenient place or places in his district, between the hours of nine o'clock in the forenoon and four o'clock in the afternoon, with his tax list, which tax list shall, during such times, be open for the inspection of all persons liable to taxation in the district, without fee or reward.

Each Assessor must give written or printed public notice, to be affixed in at least eight conspicuous places in his district, of the time and place at which his tax list shall be open for inspection, as provided in the last preceding section.

Any person whose name may appear on such tax list, and who shall have made his returns to the Assessor as hereinbefore provided, and if entitled to exemption shall have claimed such exemption, and who may deem himself aggrieved by any excess made by the Assessor in the valuation of the property as returned, or in the amount or character thereof, or whereby the amount payable by such a person is increased beyond the amount which would be payable by him according to such return, or whose claim for exemption shall not have been allowed, may appeal from such assessment, on lodging with the Tax Assessor, on or before the 5th day of October, a notice in writing, stating his grounds of objection to his assessment, or to such portion thereof as the objection applies to, and depositing therewith a sum for cost of appeal as follows:

Where the exception or reduction claimed from the tax list shall amount to two dollars or under, twenty-five cents for costs; over two dollars and under five dollars, fifty cents costs; over five dollars and under ten dollars, one dollar costs; and so on for every additional five or part of five dollars tax, fifty cents additional costs.

On receiving the amount of costs the Tax Assessor shall grant to the persons appealing a certificate in the form hereinafter appearing, to be furnished to the Assessor in blank by the Minister of Finance:

This is to certify that..... of this district, is assessed for the year as follows: Property tax..... value real..... value personal..... amount dog tax..... poll, school and road tax..... That..... disputes..... and that I have received on deposit the sum of..... dollars for the costs of this appeal.
..... Tax Assessor.
..... District.

Each Tax Assessor shall, on receiving any notice of objection, forward the same to the President of the Board of Appeals of his district.

TAX COLLECTORS.

Tax Collectors should commence their work as soon after the 1st day of November as possible, first filing with the Governor a bond, with two sureties, to the Minister of Finance, in a sum equal to the amount of taxes to be collected by them, as shown by the assessment list. The Tax Collector should add to his list any person or property in his district, not included in his list, liable to assessment, and collect the taxes upon the same, entering them in a separate part of his book as "Taxes not Assessed." The Tax Collectors should be careful to note all persons qualified to vote in the proper columns, and should carefully fill all columns requiring to be filled on the right hand pages only. They will deliver to each person paying the dog tax a tag, charging ten cents for the same, entering the number of the tag and amount received.

Each Tax Collector shall give public notice by advertisement in at least two newspapers, and by posting the same in at least three conspicuous places in his district, notifying the tax-payers to pay to him their annual taxes, at such place or places in the district, and at such a time or times during the months of November and December, not being later than the fifteenth day of December, as such notice shall appoint, and it shall be the duty of such Tax Collectors to attend at the times and places specified for the purpose of receiving such taxes. And each tax-payer shall pay all taxes due by him to the Collector on or before the fifteenth day of December, without any further notification or demand.

If any tax-payer shall fail or neglect to pay his taxes to the Tax Collector on or before the fifteenth day of December, the Tax Collector may levy the same by distress upon so much of the goods and chattels of such person as he may deem sufficient for the payment of the taxes due, and expenses of collection, and sell the same, upon the order of a District or Police Magistrate, after a public notice of five days. Or the Collector may sue for the amount of taxes in his own name, on behalf of the Hawaiian Government, with ten per cent. added thereto, in any District or Police Court, notwithstanding the amount claimed, and execution may issue therefor the same as in ordinary civil suits. Provided, that no property, not especially exempt from taxation, shall be exempted from levy and sale under such execution. And, provided also, that in case of personal taxes, if no property can be found whereon to levy, the Tax Collector shall have authority, between the 1st day of November and the 30th day of June following, to order any constable to take such person before any District or Police Justice, and the defendant, if able bodied, may, by sentence of said Judge or Magistrate, be imprisoned at hard labor until he discharge the amount of his tax and costs, at the rate of fifty cents per day.

The Collector shall keep all goods distrained, at the expense of the owner, until the day of sale ordered by the District Judge or Police Magistrate, unless a bond be given for the production of the same at the time required by such order. Such sale shall be at public auction, and any surplus remaining after paying the taxes assessed and the costs of collection, as allowed by said Judge or Magistrate, shall be returned to the owner of the property, with an account of said sale, and the costs and charges thereof, if demanded.

In case where, after using due diligence, taxes cannot be collected, the Tax Collector must file with the Governor a sworn list, containing names and places of residence, so far as can be ascertained, and amount due by each person. Tax Collectors must, on or before the last day of December, in the year preceding an election for representatives, make out a list of persons qualified to vote, and pass the same to the Inspectors of Election.

When the collection is finished, the Tax Collector must carefully add all the columns on each page, proving the correctness of each, and recapitulate the footings by pages, on the right hand pages only.

The footings of the column of "Anahu Kula" will show the amount of taxes to be paid to the School Treasurer of the district, from whom a receipt in duplicate should be taken, one of which should be sent to the President of the Board of Education. On filing with the School Treasurer an oath, taken before a Magistrate, that the amount of school tax, entered in his book, is all that he has been able to collect, and a sworn list containing the names of persons from whom he has been unable to collect the tax, with their place of residence, so far as may be known, the School Treasurer will pay the commission allowed by law on the amount. The footings of the column "Honolulu or Anahu Mau" will show the amount to be paid to the Minister of Finance, and upon filing with the Governor a like oath and list, the Minister of Finance will pay the commission allowed by law on the amount, on the certificate of the Governor.

It shall be the duty of each Collector, on or before the last day of December in each year, to pay over to the Governor of the Island in which his district is situated, the amount of taxes by him collected, with the exception of such taxes as now or may hereafter be required by law to be paid to any other Government officer or department; and any Collector who shall have failed to do so at the time last specified, shall be liable to forfeit ten per cent. of the amount of compensation for his services as Collector, which forfeiture shall be at the discretion of the Minister of Finance; and it shall be the duty of the Minister of Finance to prosecute, on or before the first day of February, the bond of any Collector who shall have failed to pay over to the Governor as aforesaid the amount of taxes prescribed in the preceding sections; and every such Collector so failing to pay over all moneys collected by him on or before the first day of March, shall be guilty of embezzlement, and be punished accordingly.
